The purpose of this trip is to provide me with an opportunity to learn and experience the French-Canadian culture. **While traveling with Sacopee Valley High School, I understand that I am a representative of the school.** In order to maintain a safe and enjoyable environment for myself and others while traveling abroad, **I agree to the following:**

- a. **I will follow all school rules** (including the **dress code** when we are in public).
- b. I will respect and cooperate with **all** chaperones, as well as our tour guides, understanding that instructions and explanations are important to me as well as to others...
- c. I will **NEVER** go anywhere alone. I understand that this is for my safety and will always travel in a group of **three (3) or more**. I will notify the chaperones of the members of my group and our intended destination, and will receive permission from them before leaving.
- d. I will follow all rules and regulations at the Youth Hostel, including the following:
 - 1. I will not bring food or drink into the room.
 - 2. I will respect the property of the Youth Hostel, in my room and common rooms.
- * I understand that my family and I are financially responsible for any damage that I cause.
- 3. I will respect the other guests and their property and will not disturb them in any way, understanding that excessive noise and clutter is unwelcome and inconsiderate.
- 4. I will not have members of the opposite sex in my room, nor will I engage in sexual activity of any kind.* We will visit in the common areas of the Youth Hostel.
 - e. I will respect and obey the curfew and lights out, and understand that these times will vary depending on the schedule, and are at the discretion of the chaperones.
 - f. I will obey all Canadian laws and regulations, and will avoid any conduct or activity which would cause harm to myself and/or to others. I understand that laws in other countries differ greatly from ours, and violators could end up in prison.*
 - g. I will not have possession of any illegal substances, drugs or drug paraphernalia (Under United States or Canadian Law).*
 - h. I will not drink or be in possession of any alcoholic beverages.*
 - i. I will not smoke or consume tobacco products.*
 - j. I will not receive body piercings or tattoos.*

* Any traveler who violates these rules or is found participating in such activity will be returned home at his/her own expense. Less severe violations will be handled by the chaperones and **will** include follow up consequences at school upon our return.
